BAIT GATHERING

Bait gathering is conducted in beach areas in front of Comboyuro Campgrounds - usually in the form of a regulation bat net used to gather small amounts of bait fish.

Yabby pumping is sometimes conducted in the legal available areas around the front of Heath Island

The camp can supply the necessary equipment but supervision is the responsibility of teachers with some knowledge of fishing and regulations

FISHING

Fishing can be conducted on the beach in front of Comboyuro Campgrounds and around the Bulwer Wrecks

If schedule includes an excursion to Tidal Flats at Heath Island, fishing can be from the beaches in that area.

Fisherpersons should bring their own equipment with strict supervision being given to fishing knives and sharp hooks.

Supervision should be by qualified teacher or adult with fishing knowledge.
